

TOWNSHIP OF BEDFORD

NOTICE OF AVAILABLE ON-PREMISES CLASS C LICENSES AND PERMITS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the Township of Bedford has available one new on-premise Class C license and/or permit which, if the Township Board of the Township of Bedford determines it to be in the best interests of the Township, and if the criteria in its Bedford Township Liquor License Ordinance (Ordinance No. 90) have been met to the satisfaction of the Township Board, may be recommended for issuance.

Any person or entity interested may apply on an application form available at the Township Clerk's Office. To be considered, an applicant shall make an application (on the Township form) to the Township Clerk's Office, pay the required non-refundable fee of \$400.00, and provide all additional information and materials required by Ordinance No. 90, as it may ever be amended, and such other items as required by the Township Board.

All completed applications, including the non-refundable fee and all required additional information, materials and items, must be received by the Township Clerk's Office no later than **4:30 p.m. on July 6, 2018**. If any application, fee or any required additional information, materials and items are not received by the Township Clerk's Office by **4:30 p.m. on July 6, 2018**, the application shall not be considered.

Although the Township Board has made a determination that it would be beneficial to the Township to evaluate the possible issuance of a new on-premises Class C license or licenses, and/or permit or permits, no applicant has a right to the issuance of a license or permit, and the Township reserves the right to exercise reasonable discretion to determine what applicant, **if any**, shall be entitled to a license or permit. **The Township Board reserves the right to not process an application, and to take no action with respect to an application. The Township Board may attach conditions to its approval for any license or permit.**

Application to the Township is in addition to, and not in place of any other application or other action which may be required by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission or any other government entity or agency.

All prospective applicants are directed to contact the Township Clerk's Office to obtain the proper forms and to obtain a copy of Ordinance No. 90. Each applicant whose application the Township chooses to review will be required to appear before the Township Board to answer questions and make a written presentation at a time to be designated by the Township.
