
The Bedford Memory Tree will be planted soon. The memory Tree was conceptualized by the committee for Celebrate Bedford. This committee was made up of a combination of people who live and or work in Bedford Township and is meant to serve the families of this community. Specifically those families who have had children pass away.

The purpose of the Memory Tree is to provide a place of quiet contemplation for family members and friends of the young people who have passed away in their youth--A place where they can peacefully reflect on their memory of the person they have lost. The Tree represents the community support of our grieving families.

The Tree will be located on Bedford Township property at the Bedford Public Library in the children's garden. This garden is maintained by the Bedford Beautification committee.

To apply for a leaf to be engraved you must be a member of the immediate family of the deceased person. You and the person to be memorialized must currently be or have been part of Bedford Township. The person to be memorialized must have been under the age of 25 when they passed away.

There will only be one leaf per person.
