

WARRANT OF THE BEDFORD TOWNSHIP CLERK DIRECTING THE BEDFORD  
TOWNSHIP TREASURER TO COLLECT THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE  
SPRINGBROOK SUBDIVISION ROAD SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BEDFORD, COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF MICHIGAN, now comes the Township Clerk of the Township of Bedford, who hereby warrants and commands the Township Treasurer of the Township of Bedford to collect the annual special assessments for the Springbrook Subdivision Road Special Assessment District, in accordance with resolutions, laws and statutes so provided.

The Township Board has determined to establish and spread among all parcels in the special assessment district, and the special assessment on each parcel in the special assessment district shall be in the principal amounts as follows:  
**\$2,000.00** per lot for parcel numbers 58-02-480-001 thru 58-02-480-015-00; and 58-02-480-017-00 thru 58-02-480-029-00; and 58-02-485-001-00 thru 58-02-485-026-00; and 58-02-030-002-00;  
**\$900.00** per lot for parcel numbers 58-02-486-001-00 thru 58-02-486-065-00 and 58-02-480-016-00; and  
**\$550.00** per lot for parcel numbers 58-02-030-001-10; 58-02-030-001-20; 58-02-030-007-00; 58-02-030-007-10 and 58-02-030-008-00; which may be paid in full or over five (5) years in equal installments, plus interest at the rate of (3.25%) three and twenty-five percent.

If the total amount of the special assessment for a benefited lot or parcel is paid in full by October 31, 2018, the special assessment for that benefited lot or parcel shall not be further collected and shall not be charged interest.

The annual assessment installments shall be billed and become payable on December 1<sup>st</sup>. If not paid in full in a timely fashion before the next February 14th, the annual assessment installments shall be considered delinquent.

The first annual assessment installment shall be billed and become payable on December 1, 2018, and each succeeding annual assessment installment shall be billed and become payable on December 1<sup>st</sup> of each succeeding year, until the last such annual assessment installment is billed and becomes payable on December 1, 2022.

In addition, said Township Clerk commands and warrants to said Township Treasurer on the 1st day of September of each year, following the date the annual assessment installments become due, to submit to the Township Board of the Township of Bedford, a sworn statement setting forth the names of the persons delinquent, a description of the parcels involved, and the amount of such delinquency. If any assessment is not paid when due, there shall be collected a penalty at the rate of one percent (1%) for each month or fraction of the month that the installment remains unpaid before being reported to the Township Board for reassessment upon the Township tax roll, in accordance with prior resolutions and the law and statutes provided.

Further, the Bedford Township Clerk sayeth not.
